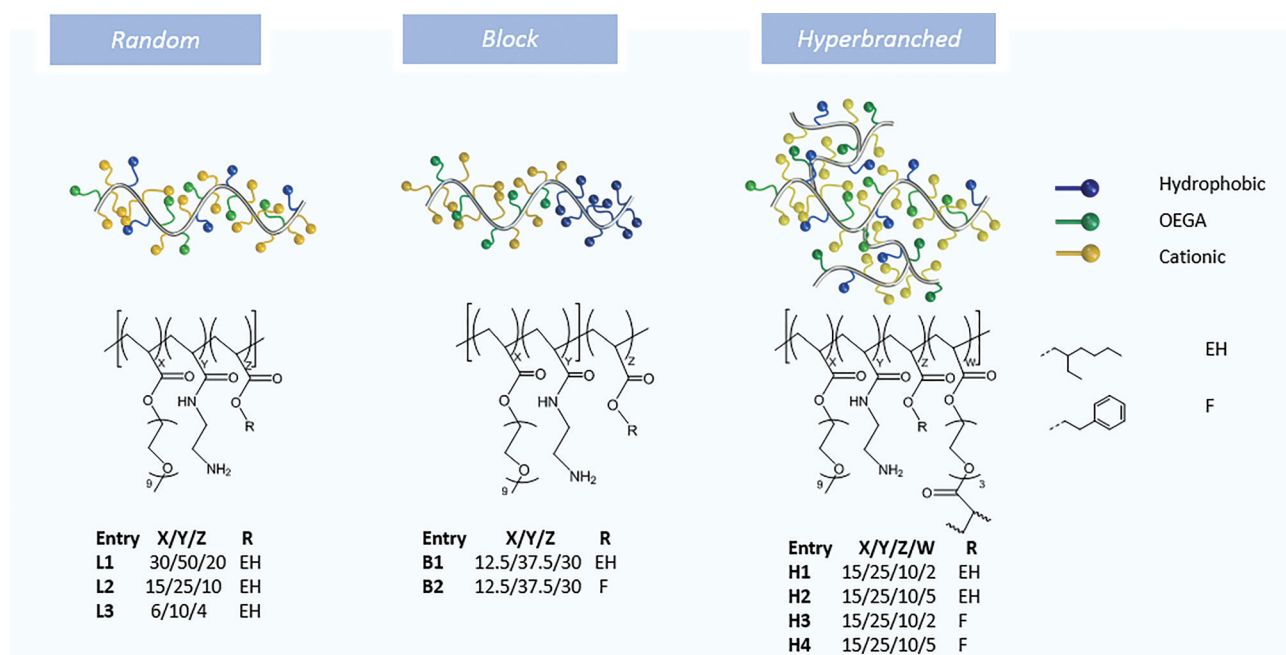


Fig. 1 The compositional structures and architectures of the amphiphilic ternary copolymers in this study.
