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## Correction: Chemoselective dehydrogenative esterification of aldehydes and alcohols with a dimeric rhodium(II) catalyst

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Correction for 'Chemoselective dehydrogenative esterification of aldehydes and alcohols with a dimeric rhodium(III) catalyst' by Junjie Cheng et al., Chem. Sci., 2016, 7, 4428–4434.

The authors regret that the incorrect temperature was stated on p. 4432, left column, line 5, of the original paper. The corrected sentence, in which "at ambient temperature" has been corrected to "at 90 °C", is as follows:

"The crude <sup>1</sup>H NMR of the mixture resulting from treating **11** with excess NaOAc (40 equivalents) in MeOH at 90 °C showed that **11** was fully converted into a small amount of **14** and a major new compound **16** (Scheme 6)."

The Royal Society of Chemistry apologises for these errors and any consequent inconvenience to authors and readers.

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
